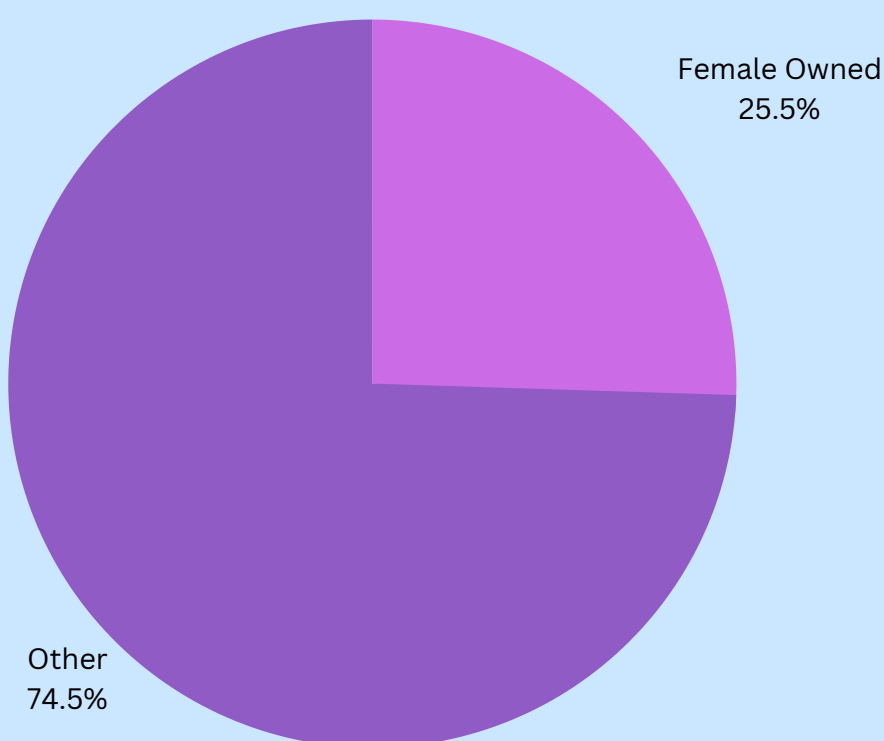


U.S. Business Data Compared by Gender

1992

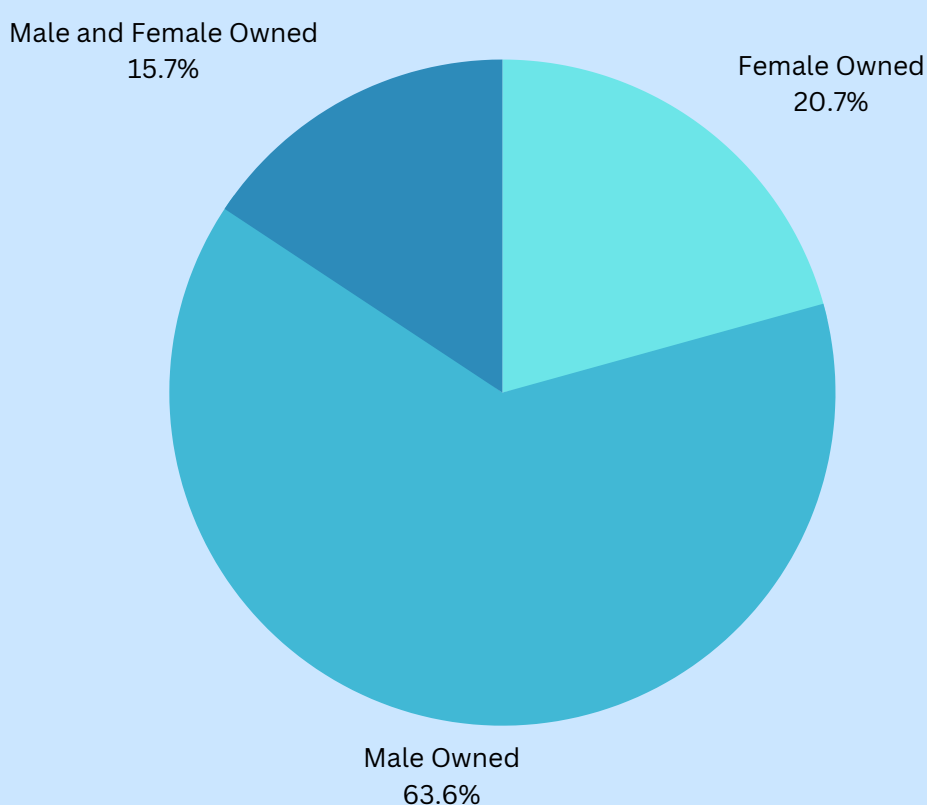
2.03 million total businesses

The average annual earnings for the employees of women owned firms is \$38,238 versus the average payroll of \$54,114 for all firms.



2017

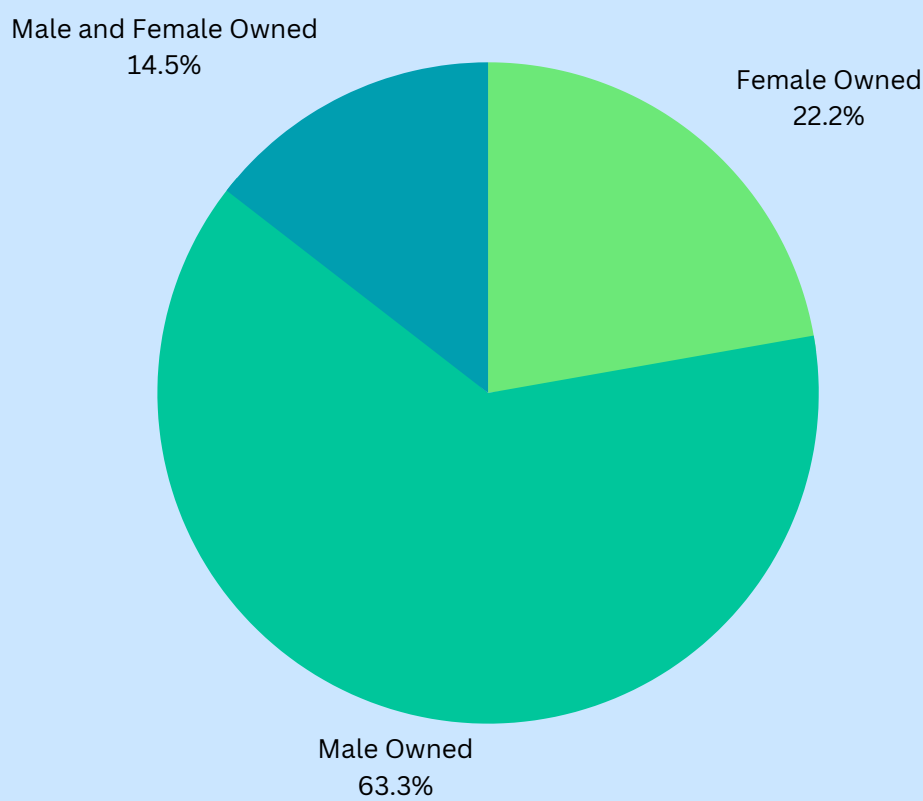
5.74 million total businesses



In 2017, there were 10.6 million women-owned firms that were self-employed, meaning that they did not work for an employer.

2020

5.77 million total businesses



Non-Hispanic women make up the highest percentage of women owned business with 92.4%. White women own 82.8% of the businesses, and 74.6% are non-minority. 98.9% of the women are non-veterans.
